Important Notes Regarding the Exam

1. Arrival and Identification:

- Students must be in the exam room at least 15 minutes before the exam starts.
- The exam starts at 10:30 for all levels.
- Students must bring the following documents to the exam:
 - o A valid official photo ID (e.g., national ID, passport, driver's license)
 - o Student ID Card

Students without a valid ID will not be allowed to take the exam.

- All electronic devices such as mobile phones, smartwatches, tablets, digital translators, and electronic
 dictionaries are strictly prohibited. These must be turned off and submitted to the designated area
 before the exam begins.
- You may use paper / printed dictionaries (English-English or English-Turkish).

2. Latecomers:

Students arriving within the first 20 minutes of the exam may still take the exam but will not be granted
 extra time. Therefore, students are strongly advised to be in the exam room before the start time.

3. During the Exam:

- RA2, RB1, and B1 students will write a paragraph worth 15 points and B2 students will write an essay worth 20 points.
- **Silence** must be maintained during the exam. Talking, sharing items (erasers, pencils, dictionaries, etc.) or any form of communication between students is **strictly forbidden**.
- Students caught cheating or violating exam rules will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Higher Education Council's Student Disciplinary Regulation No. 28388.
- Except in urgent and exceptional situations, students cannot leave the exam room during the exam.

4. Leaving the Classroom:

- Students may not leave the exam room within the first 30 minutes of the exam. After the first 30 minutes, students who have completed the exam must submit all exam materials properly and leave the room quietly to avoid disturbing others.
- Re-entry into the room is not allowed for any reason once a student has left. This rule is to maintain exam security and integrity.
