Important Rules and Regulations

1. Entry to the Exam Room and ID Check

- Students must be present in the exam room at least 15 minutes before the exam starts.
- The exam will begin at 13:30 for all levels.
- Students must bring **at least one** of the following documents with them:
 - o A valid official photo ID (national ID card, passport, or driver's license), OR
 - Student ID card
- Students who do not present a valid ID will not be allowed to take the exam.
- The use of mobile phones, smart watches, tablets, digital translation devices, electronic dictionaries, or any similar electronic devices is strictly prohibited.
- All electronic devices must be **turned off** and handed in to the area designated by the invigilator before the exam begins.

2. Late Arrivals

- Students who arrive within the first 20 minutes of the exam may be admitted; however, no extra time will be given.
- Therefore, students are strongly advised to arrive at the exam room before the exam start time.

3. During the Exam

- In the writing exam, students are required to complete **two writing tasks**, each worth **10 points**.
- Absolute silence must be maintained throughout the exam.
- Talking, exchanging items, or any form of communication is strictly prohibited.
- Students who cheat or violate exam rules will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Regulation on Student Discipline in Higher Education Institutions (No. 28388).
- Except for compulsory or exceptional circumstances, students are **not allowed to leave the exam room** during the exam.

4. Leaving the Exam Room

- Students are **not permitted to leave** the exam room during the **first 30 minutes**.
- After the first 30 minutes, students who have completed the exam may leave the room **quietly**, provided that they submit all exam materials completely and correctly.
- Students who leave the exam room will not be allowed to re-enter during the exam period.

• The writing tasks will be graded according to the writing rubric provided on the exam paper.
