# **Instructions for Students**

# 1. Arrival and Identification:

- Students must be in the exam room at least 15 minutes before the exam starts.
- The exam will start at 13.30 for all levels.
- Students must bring the following documents to the exam:
  - o A valid official photo ID (e.g., national ID card, passport, driver's license)
  - Student ID card

Students without valid identification will not be allowed to take the exam.

• All electronic devices such as mobile phones, smartwatches, tablets, digital translators, and electronic dictionaries are strictly prohibited. These must be turned off and submitted to the designated area before the exam begins.

# 2. Latecomers:

• Students arriving within the **first 20 minutes** of the exam may still take the exam but **will not be granted extra time**. Therefore, students are strongly advised to be in the exam room before the start time.

# 3. During the Exam:

- You will be given a quiz with several types of questions based on the readers of each level. The types of questions are as follows:
  - multiple-choice questions
  - fill-in-the blank questions with first letters given
  - true / false statements
  - short answer questions
  - matching characters to descriptions questions
  - writing opinion-based short paragraphs about the characters in readers
  - chronological event ordering
  - matching quotes to characters in readers
- **Silence** must be maintained during the exam. Talking, sharing items, or any form of communication between students is **strictly forbidden**.
- Students caught cheating or violating exam rules will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the **Higher Education Council's Student Disciplinary Regulation No. 28388**.
- Except in urgent and exceptional situations, students cannot leave the exam room during the exam.
- 4. Leaving the Classroom:
  - Students may not leave the exam room within the first 30 minutes of the exam.
  - After the first 30 minutes, students who have completed the exam must **submit all exam materials** properly and **leave the room quietly** to avoid disturbing others.
  - **Re-entry into the room is not allowed** for any reason once a student has left. This rule is to maintain **exam security and integrity**.
